Marina di Pisa: the agreement for the realization of the park in the area “La Camilla” has been signed today

An important intervention for environmental and social requalification

Pisa, 21st March 2016 – The Municipality of Pisa and the company OLT Offshore LNG Toscana signed today the agreement for the realization of an equipped park in the area “La Camilla” in Marina di Pisa.

It is a very significant action for the territory of Pisa, that will involve the area “La Camilla” as subject of an important requalification intervention both environmental, thanks to the planting of three different kind of native species, and social, since the area up to now was in a state of decay and abandonment. This project aims to promote environmental education to children through play. The area “La Camilla”, much visited by citizens, is adjacent to the town forest, next to sport facilities and located next to another playground for babies. The project will be developed on three environmental themes that characterize the littoral zone: the forest, the dunes and the sea. Within each area there will be playground equipment to allow children to interact through the game with different natural environments. Kids will live, for example, the experience of the tree house, they could climb trees or experience the feeling of swaying in the ocean.

Within the area there will be some information boards, concerning the environmental emergencies of the Regional Park ‘Massaciuccoli Migliarino San Rossore’, furnished with benches and recycle bins.

The agreement is part of the environmental compensations in accordance with the EIA Decree related to the project of the regasification terminal “FSRU Toscana”, off the coast between Livorno and Pisa. The works for the realization of the park, financed by OLT with a contribution of one hundred thousand euro, will be organized by the Municipality of Pisa through a public tender. The finalization of the work is scheduled in two years from the delivery of the project.

*“The project of the park in the area ‘La Camilla’ in Marina di Pisa” – declared **Olt Offshore LNG Toscana** – “is reason for great satisfaction because it represents another important intervention in the territory with environmental and social purposes, in line with our philosophy. This project is part of a cooperation with the Municipality of Pisa, we have worked with during these years successfully, also for the reopening of the Incile Canal, another action that will bring substantial socio-economic benefits to the territory”.*

*“Soon the Incile will stop being a dream and will become reality. The connection between the Arno and the channel Navicelli favors boating and tourism. These are works that the Municipality obtained as a compensation for the positioning of OLT terminal in front of Calambrone. Furthermore, today we announce another project, which will be realized by the Municipality and funded by OLT; it is the park of La Camilla in Marina di Pisa: a degraded area which will be recovered through new plantings, and which social function will be restored” - declared **Marco Filippeschi, Mayor of the Municipality of Pisa.***

*“This intervention is part of the more general framework of investment of the Municipal Administration in new equipped areas on the coast that exceeds two hundred thousand euro” – said **Paolo Ghezzi, Deputy Mayor of the Municipality of Pisa with proxy to public parks and gardens.** “It is the most significant investment among all the CTP of the city of Pisa for a total amount of over one million euro. The design quality is high and adorned with a graphic project that will cite the works of Giuseppe Viviani for the coastal areas. It is also important to highlight the fulfillment of the compensation expected by the EIA Decree, even also in a key sector for the communities such as the green socialization areas”.*



OLT Offshore LNG Toscana S.p.A., set up from the association of Iren Group (49.07%), Uniper Global Commodities SE (48.24%) and Golar Offshore Toscana Limited (2.69%), holds the property of the floating regasification Terminal "FSRU Toscana" and it is responsible for the related operation management. "FSRU Toscana", moored about 22 km off the coasts between Livorno and Pisa, is connected to the national grid through a 36.5 km long pipeline, operated and managed by Snam Rete Gas, of which: about 29.5 km at sea, 5 km in the floodway and the remaining 2 km on dry land. At full capacity, the Terminal has a regasification capacity of 3.75 billion cubic meters a year, about 4% of the national requirement.
